College letters should be addressed to the head coach. Proper grammar and correct spelling is crucial. Make sure that several people proofread your letters. Letters should include the following information which can be an attachment:

- Father's Name and occupation
- Mother's Name and occupation
- Siblings names and ages

- NCAA Clearinghouse information
- ACT and/or SAT Scores (Best Composite)
- High School Core GPA
- Class Rank
- Anticipated College Major

III. BASEBALL INFORMATION

- Home to First
- High School Coach along with contact information

INTRODUCTION LETTER EXAMPLE

SCHEDULE LETTER EXAMPLE
