We're excited to share some major progress on our youth baseball field renovation project! Thanks to the hard work of our volunteers and partners, the field is starting to look better than ever. Here's a quick look at what's been accomplished so far:

- Foul poles and bases have been freshly painted
- Moss has been fully removed from the outfield and perimeter fencing
 - The scoreboard has received a fresh new coat of paint
- Dugouts were pressure washed and then painted for a clean, sharp look
 - The backstop has been repaired and reinforced
 - Sun shades have been installed above the bleachers
 - New spotlight and American flag have gone up
 - Brand new dirt has been added across the infield
- Grading has been corrected and infield lips smoothed out for safer play
 - The pitcher's mound and bullpens have been fully reestablished
 - Hitter's backdrop added to outfield fence
 - Grass and weed treatments have begun across the field
 - Batting cages and nets have been repaired and reinforced
 - Brand new turf mats have been installed inside the cages
 - Concession stand is being cleaned out and refreshed

We're making incredible strides toward creating a safe, functional, and beautiful field for our players and the community. We look forward to the continued relationship with the community and HOA and hope we can help renovate the three additional fields in the future!

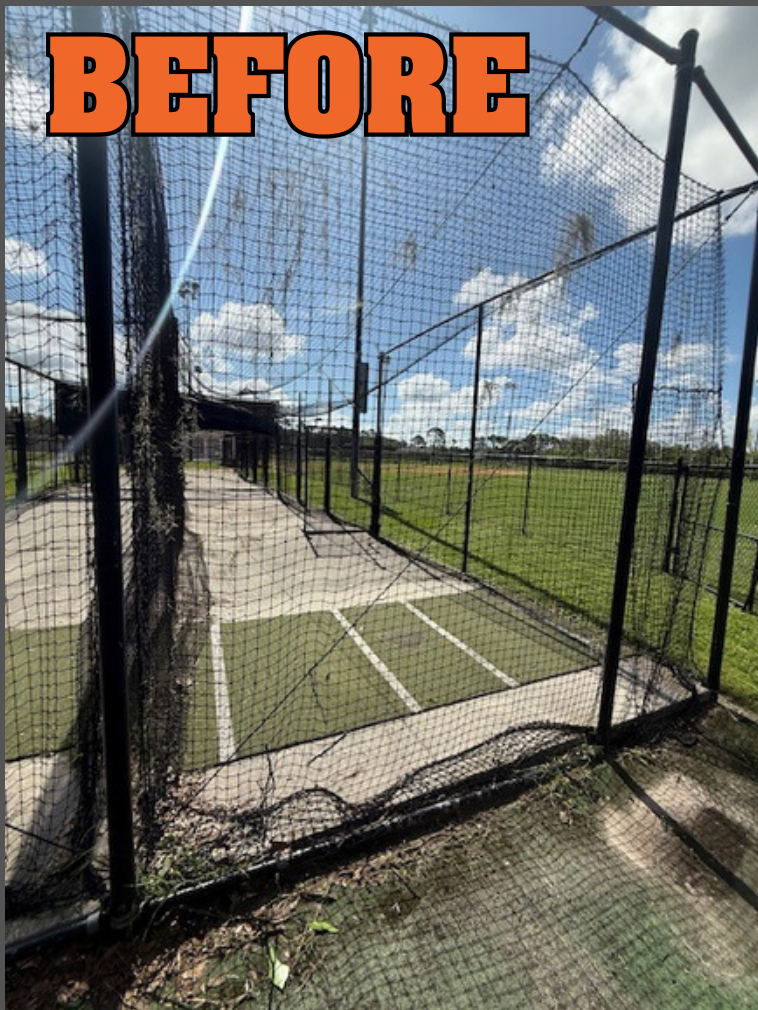

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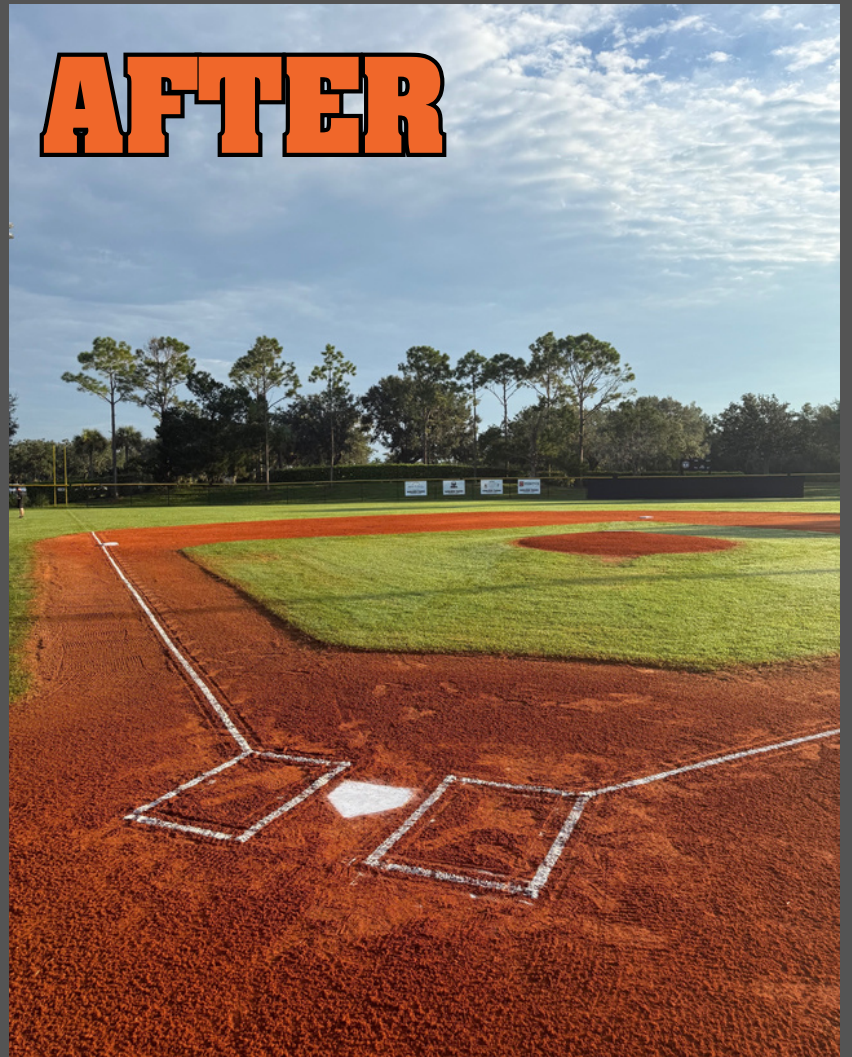

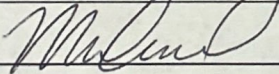
